**Subject:** **EXEMPTIONS FROM CERTAIN REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC: MEDICAL ASSESSMENT AND CERTIFICATE**

You will recall that the NCAA issued an All Operators Letter AOL DG046/20 reference number NCAA/DG/AIR/11/16/288 dated 30<sup>th</sup> December 2020 to inform the industry of the issuance of Exemption Document No **NCAA/AMS/GEN012/20/001 dated 30<sup>th</sup> December 2020** for medical assessment and certificate.

After an assessment of the current situation of the second wave of the COVID-19 pandemic, the NCAA finds that a limited relief is still justified with regards to **medical assessment and certificate** and have consequently decided to grant another time-limited exemption in accordance with Nig. CARs Part 1.4 on the subject matter as follows:

1. Medical Assessment and Certificate Exemption- **NCAA/AMS/GEN012/21/001**

**Action Required**

All Holders of Nigerian Aircrew and ATCO Medical Certificates and Authorized Aviation Medical Examiners (AAMEs) are hereby required to note the attached Exemption Document No. **NCAA/AMS/GEN012/21/001 dated 28<sup>th</sup> January 2021** and comply with the conditions and limitations contained therein. A copy of this AOL and Exemption Document should be carried along with the applicable licence as no endorsement would be made by the NCAA.
