Subject: **VALIDITY OF PERSONNEL LICENCES**

You will recall that NCAA issued All Operators Letter AOL DG008/20 reference number NCAA/DG/AIR/11/16/111 dated 1st April 2020 to permit all holders of NCAA issued personnel licences to continue to exercise the privileges of their licences and/ ratings till 30th June 2020.

NCAA also issued All Operators Letter AOL DG018/20 to grant exemptions on certain regulatory requirements related to flight crew recency and proficiency and AOL DG020/20 to grant exemption on certain regulatory requirements related to medical assessment and certificate. In order to ensure aviation safety, these exemptions conditions and limitations require certain Safety Risk Assessments to be conducted by all operators and submitted to the NCAA prior to their benefiting from the exemptions.

The NCAA has reviewed the status of all airline operators' preparation for the airline industry restart and discovered that several airlines are still lagging in submitting the safety risk assessment.

The NCAA has determined that all personnel whose licences had expired from 1st April 2020 can continue to exercise the privileges of their licences and/ratings for another extended period of up to 31st July 2020. This is to enable the airlines to comply with the conditions and limitations of the exemptions and give ample time to NCAA to process the renewal of such licences.
